Installation and Upgrade

Before you install or upgrade Data Integration Hub, verify that your system meets the minimum requirements and follow the pre-installation steps. For information about installing or upgrading Data Integration Hub, see the Data Integration Hub Installation and Configuration Guide.

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Installation and Upgrade Limitations

The following table describes known installation and upgrade limitations:

Issue	Description
DIHD-1040	When you install Data Integration Hub on a Windows Operating system, if you install the Data Integration Hub client plugin for PowerCenter component and define a custom ODBC connection string, the string, user name, and password that you define during the installation are not saved to the plugin. When you create custom workflows, event status names are not loaded into PowerCenter Designer. Workaround: Take one of the following steps: Enter the string, user name, and password in the following file: <data directory="" hub="" installation="" integration="">/powercenter/plugin version/dxplugin., where Data Integration Hub installation directory is the directory in which you have installed Data Integration Hub and version is the version number of the Data Integration Hub server plugin. Manually enter event status names in PowerCenter Designer.</data>
DIHD-871	On an existing installation where HTTPS is enabled, if you add the Dashboard and Reports component, the dashboard does not open in the Operation Console. Workaround: After you install the Dashboard and Reports component, perform the following steps: 1. Change the value of the system property dx.dashboard.url to an HTTPS path and port number. By, default, 18443 instead of 18080. 2. Open the Logi Info Dashboard license file _Settings_encrypted.lgx from the following location: <definitions 3.="" 4.="" and="" data="" dx.dashboard.url.="" dx_console_url="" edit="" entered="" hub="" in="" integration="" logonfailpage="" match="" of="" parameters="" property="" restart="" services.<="" system="" td="" that="" the="" to="" values="" you=""></definitions>
XE-8373	On an existing Data Integration Hub installation where you changed your configuration files since the installation, when you add components to Data Integration Hub using the Data Integration Hub installer, the Data Integration Hub installer does not present the configuration data that you modified after the original installation during the component installation. Workaround: Verify that the data that the installer presents during component installation is correct, and correct it if required.

Fixed Limitations

Review the Release Notes of previous releases for information about previous fixed limitations.

CR	Description
DIHD-1393	Validation of duplicate names while creating a publication, subscription, topic, monitor, or workflow happens at the end of creation.
DIHD-1392	When you create a monitor, the Disable option is enabled even if you have Read-Only permission.
DIHD-1389	If you have Read-Write privilege without View privilege, the existing categories are deleted if you open and save a workflow without editing it.
DIHD-1387	You cannot change the event status of the publication or subscription of the topic you have Readonly access to if you have Read-Only permission on a category with Change Event's Status privilege.
DIHD-1386	You can view categories without the View privilege on categories.

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CR	Description
DIHD-1381	You can delete a workflow with Read-Only permission.
DIHD-1380	You have assigned categories and topics, with Read-Only permission. If you create a publication, an error is displayed.
DIHD-1379	You can view unassigned categories without appropriate permission.
DIHD-1374	The Advanced search on the Events List page, shows incorrect event list.
DIHD-1373	When you import an IICS template based Publication or Subscription, the internal reference workflow is not added on the Data Integration Hub Operation Console.
DIHD-1371	When you use Data Integration Hub on Microsoft Windows Server 2019, you cannot launch or use the Transformation Developer in PowerCenter Designer. Workaround: Install PowerCenter Designer on a different operating system.
DIHD-1368	When you hover on a publication on the Data Integration Hub Homepage, the lineage and dependent subscriptions are not displayed.
DIHD-1364	The system imports the IDQ (Informatica Data Quality) and BDM (Big Data Management) workflow without validating the license.
DIHD-1352	When you create a Data Integration Hub relational connection for an SQL server, if the password contains semicolon or square brackets, an error might be displayed.
DIHD-1345	If you enable Delta Detection for an unbound Subscription, the Delete on Target option is not enabled under the Delivery Options .
DIHD-1340	When you tamper and open the Data Integration Hub help URL, an exception error is displayed before the object opens.
DIHD-1339	Subscription API Notification URL allows string with empty spaces.
DIHD-925	While installing Data Integration Hub on a Windows operating system, if you do not select an option on the Installation Components page and navigate to the previous page then, you cannot navigate back to the Installation Components page. Workaround: Verify that at least one component is selected on the Installation Components page before you leave the page.
B2BT-1177	Data Integration Hub processes non ASCII characters, like Chinese characters, using Data Driven subscriptions.

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Known Limitations

CR	Description
DIHD-1036	After you change the default file group on the Data Integration Hub publication repository, when you edit a topic that was created before the change, a message informs you that unconsumed data that was published from the topic will be discarded. Topics that existed before you changed the default file group continue to publish to the file group
	that was the default group when the topic was created. Changing the default file group does not discard unconsumed data that was published before the change.
DIHD-1032	For publications with a publication pre-process, the Event Average Processing Time report does not calculate the pre-processing time.
DIHD-1020	Subscription runs fail when the subscription contains a filter for a column with a TEXT data type with a Does Not Equal operator and the option Use pushdown optimization is enabled for the subscription.
DIHD-1018	When you change the default data storage location on the publication repository, a warning message appears, stating that the storage location has changed and that the topic tables will be recreated. The topic metadata is changed and holds the new default storage location. Topic tables are not recreated on the new storage location, and remain on the old storage location. Workaround: Edit the topic and change the Data Storage Location to the new default data storage location on the publication repository.
XE-8752	Microsoft SQL database where partitioning is enabled: If the retention period of a topic is set to one day Data Integration Hub cannot delete the topic data from the publication repository. Only data that is older than one day is moved onto the partition. Workaround: Set topic retention period for two or more days.
XE-8333	When you use a database password that ends with the # character, Data Integration Hub enters the password into the PowerCenter connection without the # character.
XE-7153	Data Integration Hub stores operational data store JDBC connection properties in the dx-configuration.properties file in addition to Data Integration Hub system properties. Workaround: If you change the JDBC connection properties in the dx-configuration.properties file, change the system properties.
