Data Loader has no additional installation, overhead, coding, or setup needed. It's the best way to easily load large data sets to your cloud data warehouse quickly and securely, with no upfront costs.

Data Loader automatically keeps up with your source data and schema changes to enable real-time insights. To fine-tune the data, you can exclude certain objects or fields and apply some simple filters.

It's compatible with out-of-the-box connectors for 40-plus data sources. You can choose to read data from a variety of source types and load it to the following target types:


- Amazon Redshift
- DataBricks Delta
- Google BigQuery
- Microsoft Azure Synapse SQL
- Snowflake Data Cloud
