

Effective from version 9.6.0, you can edit and manage business glossaries in Informatica Analyst. Metadata Manager business glossaries are deprecated. You can use Metadata Manager to extract metadata from business glossaries in the Analyst tool. This document works as a documentation quick reference and contains information about multiple Business Glossary documentation deliverables. You can open the documents from the links provided, and find specific information for different business glossary tasks.

This document assumes that you have a working knowledge of the data for your organization.
